Gifts between \$10,000 - \$100,000 will qualify donors to make a gift in support of a particular space or fund. Donors will be recognized for making that space possible through their generosity (E.g. “The Loading Dock is a gift of John & Mary Doe”).

All gifts of \$500 or more will be recognized on the “Community Donor” section of the Donor Wall and all donors, regardless of gift size, will be named in our “Honor Roll of Donors” listing to be published in print and online at the conclusion of the campaign.

All donors have the option to make their gift anonymously and/or to make their gift “In Honor Of/In Memory Of” an individual, group or organization.
