COLD WEATHER ACCESSORIES

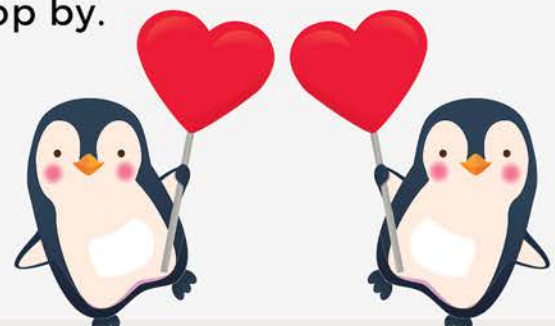


Please stop by if you are in need of hats, gloves, scarves, or mittens for the winter, We have all sizes available!
